
Train Walks

The Penistone line runs through an area of outstanding natural beauty. Villages and small towns along its route are connected not only by rail but also by an intricate and ancient network of footpaths and bridleways.



Denby Dale sits at the centre and its Walkers Are Welcome group have devised a series of 10 new trails, Train Walks. These walks connect villages and stations at points along the line from Dodworth to Berry Brow.



The idea of Train Walks is to take an outward journey from a Denby Dale and walk back, though this can be reversed to meet your needs. The network map shows the train walks as well as circular walks from Denby Dale. Visit our website to find out more about walks together with local information to plan your trip.

There are also other trails to explore from Denby Dale. There are 4 circular walks from or very near the station and also train walks from Denby Dale to Penistone and Shepley.






